The Wine Trust

- **707 Sauvignon Blanc – California** - Notes of fresh cut hay and juicy honeydew melon. The refreshing 707 Sauvignon Blanc would pair nicely with freshly prepared shellfish like oysters on the half shell, shrimp cocktail, cracked crab, ceviche or lighter style luncheon salads. **\$18.95**
- **707 Chardonnay – California** - A honeyed, golden-yellow color. Aromas are reminiscent of green apples, vanilla bean, and apricots. Smooth and silky, with intricate textures to include tropical fruits and a large dash of citrus freshness. Sparkling acidity that makes the flavors light and lively, yet also rich with vanilla-laced oak and a hint of caramel. Bright finish. Try with lobster risotto, broccoli chicken fettuccini or a pumpkin ravioli bisque. **\$18.95**
- **Bernadotte Chardonnay – France** - Delicate and slight vanilla aromas. Fresh and tasty on the palate. the nose has floral notes as well as some citrus fragrances. Pairs well with grilled or sauced poultry as well as with seafood platters. **\$18.95**
- **Bernadotte Pinot Noir – France** – Youthful and fruit forward with fresh raspberry and strawberry aromas and a touch of smoke on the nose. Soft and plummy with vibrant acidity, this wine pairs well with grilled red and white meats as well as sauced dishes like “Coq au Vin” **\$18.95**
- **Daniel Ford Pinot Noir – Oregon** - Bright ruby color and gorgeous aromatics of red cherry, wild strawberry, and earthiness. Pure vibrant fruit with that signature Oregon earthiness. Silky tannins frame flavors of cranberry, pomegranate, and hints of baking spice, with the mineral backbone that comes from Oregon’s volcanic soils. The finish is elegant with subtle notes of rose petal. Beautiful now but has the structure to develop over the next 5-10 years. Everything you want from serious Oregon Pinot Noir – complexity without weight, power without heat. **\$26.95**
- **707 Cabernet Sauvignon – California** - Sonoma county in a glass. Bright Blueberry and Blackberry fruit on the nose. Smooth, fine tannins balance out with mocha and a hint of allspice. Blueberry and blackberry balance out the palate of this medium to full bodied wine. **\$18.95**
- **Nespoli Borgo Dei Guidi Sangiovese/Cabernet – Italy** - Soft and enveloping, it displays an intense red hue and a persistent aroma rich in red fruits, blackberry jam, and spicy notes of licorice. Full-bodied and concentrated on the palate, yet well-balanced with very fine tannins. Pairs harmoniously with stuffed poultry, foie gras, roasts, braised dishes, and aged cheese. **\$29.95**

Blueprint Spirits

- **Town Branch Overproof 104' – Kentucky Straight Whiskey** - This blend of 90% bourbons and 10% rye whiskey delivers a rich and complex profile, offering a bold yet nuanced drinking experience. Designed to enhance cocktails with concentrated flavors, providing body, texture, and structure. Hints of deep oak, clove, brown sugar and cinnamon. **\$37.95**
- **Town Branch True Cask 116.6' – Kentucky Straight Bourbon** - Attention to detail at every level of production from distillation, mash bill, yeast, fermentation, and cooperage, to the final blend of uncut straight from the barrel whiskey. Individually batch numbered to capture the purity of flavors each cask strength barrel provides to each blend. Flavors of Sweet corn, vanilla, cinnamon and apricot. **\$42.95**
- **Town Branch Maple Stout Finished 94' – Kentucky Straight Bourbon** - Finished in freshly decanted Kentucky Maple Barrel Imperial Stout barrels for over 12-months to add flavors of the beer alongside traditional flavors of bourbon. Mash Bill: 72% Corn / 15% Rye / 13% Malted Barley. Flavors of maple, cocoa, brown sugar and cherry. **\$63.95**
- **Redwood Empire Grizzly Beast BIB 100' – California Straight Bourbon** – This rare bonded straight bourbon whiskey was aged in the temperate climate of the Northern California coast and bottled under the strict tenets of the Bottled-in-Bond Act of 1897. Each release can only be made from barrels we produced within a six-month time span. Collectible and one of a kind, these bottled-in-bond batches will never be replicated and are ever-changing. This is the purest expression of Redwood Empire's craft. Notes of nutmeg, sticky toffee and cedar. **\$68.95**
- **Redwood Empire Screaming Titan 96' – California Wheated Bourbon** - Our small lot series allows us to continue our spirit of experimentation by applying our hard-won house style to products with a specific focus. This wheated bourbon whiskey is in a league of its own. Nectarine, Sweet Tea, Apple Blossoms on the nose. Honeycomb, Flakey Pastry, Peaches & Cream on the palate. **\$73.95**
- **Short Path Flagship Gin 86' – Everett, MA** - An approachable, easy drinking American style gin. Crafted in handmade copper pot stills in Everett, Massachusetts, our signature Gin is made with organic ingredients to create a bright and floral spirit with distinct, pleasant notes of lavender and eucalyptus. Botanicals Juniper, Coriander, Lavender, Eucalyptus, and Lemongrass. **\$29.95**

Craft Collective Homegrown (Wine)

- **Tenuta Giol Serata Prosecco NV – Italy** - 100% Glera. Organic, Light-bodied, crisp, and lively, with notes of citrus and a touch of honey. It's a dry, well-balanced, and harmonious Prosecco with delicate tropical fruit notes. Organic ingredient for mimosas or any cocktail demanding some fizz! Pairs with fish! Cheers! **\$23.95**
- **Quinta da Alorna Sauvignon Blanc – Portugal** - Exuberant aroma, harmonious tropical notes of pineapple, grapefruit and guava, herbal notes of asparagus. Structured flavor, revealing a distinct touch of complexity and a superb minerality perfectly combined with the ripped tropical fruit notes. **\$15.95**
- **Quinta da Alorna Lutra Tinto (Red) – Portugal** - Indigenous Portuguese grape varieties Touriga Nacional, Castelão, and Trincadeira, and showcasing a medium-bodied profile with soft tannins and vibrant red-berry notes, making it approachable and enjoyable for any day drinking. **\$11.95**
- **Herdade do Sabroso Tinto (Red) – Portugal** – A wine of intense and concentrated color. Fine aroma, with hints of ripe fruit and chocolate in a smooth and harmonious combination. A smooth red, well-structured red in the mouth, round, fresh and with balanced acidity. **\$19.95**
- **Quinta da Pedra Alta Pedra a Pedra Tinto (Red) – Portugal** - An approachable, fruit driven, structured Douro red, made from a blend of indigenous grape varieties grown on the schist soils of our terraced vineyards. Red and blue fruit with lifted aromatics and spice notes. Full flavored, red and blue fruited wine, with good structure, balanced acidity and a long finish. **\$22.95**
- **Pizza Wine Sparkling Red in a can! – Rhode Island** - Lightly sparkling, highly crushable, canned red wine, best served chilled. Produced by an award-winning team, Pizza Wine was started by friends with a shared love for pizza and wine. The fruitiness pairs with the zesty tomato sauce. The acidity cuts through fats like cheese and pepperoni. The bubbles wash everything down for a crisp, refreshing finish. **\$6.95/can 250ml 24.95/4pk**
- **Per Se' Aperitivo – Portugal** - Aperitif created with 24 botanicals that combine in a unique blend. Bright warm orange, reminiscent of the iconic Southern European sunsets. Aroma with hints of cardamom, orange, Jamaican pepper and Portuguese hop give this aperitif a balanced refreshing twist. Light, sweet, delicate and small bitterness on the palate with all its 24 botanicals contributing to a rich ensemble of flavors. This well-guarded secret brings us the light, color and essence of southern Europe. A secret called PER SE! **\$28.95**

Craft Collective Homegrown (Beer)

- **Schilling Alexandr Pils – Lager - Littleton NH** - Crisp, clean and sessionable, with a firm but rounded hop backbone, Alexandr is the first and original Czech-style pilsner crafted at Schilling. Authentic raw materials shine, and so will almost any beer-friendly food that's paired with this Czech-inspired lager. **\$14.55/4pk 16oz**
- **Mast Landing A Beer Named Duck – Pale Ale – Maine** - This easy drinking New England pale ale proves that exceptional qualities can come in unassuming forms. Simcoe, Centennial, and Cascade hops flock together to bring crisp notes of citrus and floral brightness. **\$15.30/4pk 16oz**
- **Foam Dead Flowers – IPA - Burlington, VT** - Dead Flowers is an IPA featuring their select Riwaka and Southern Cross hops. This beer is truly a beauty, presenting notes of fresh melon, tropical fruit juice, a hint of lime, and an overall experience that reminds of us of a creamsicle. **\$17.55/4pk 16oz**
- **Kettlehead Brewing Pulpy – New England IPA – NH** - Meet Pulpy, he's a friend of ours and he loves juicy IPAs. This one happens to be his favorite. Triple dry hopped with a combination of mosaic, citra, and El Dorado hops. And no there is no pulp in this beer. **\$19.30/4pk 16oz**
- **Dorchester Brewing Punch Bowl – Fruited Kettle Sour – Boston, MA** - Seasonal fruited sour, fermented with pineapple, black currant, pink guava, and lime. Beautiful orange-pink in the glass, with a lightly sweet aroma packed full of fruit notes and lime pith. Punchbowl drinks tart, tangy, and tropical, with strong melted popsicle and sour candy vibes, balanced between the four-fruit cocktail. **\$14.80/4pk 16oz**
- **SoMe Brewing Whoopie Pie Stout – Stout – York, ME** - Our flagship Milk Stout aged on Cocoa Nibs and Vanilla Beans. Lactose (Milk Sugar) is added to this beer to gain the sweet creamy mouthfeel. Full Bodied Stout. Sweet w/ big chocolate and vanilla notes. Tastes much bigger than the abv suggests. **15.55/4pk 16oz**

Main Street Wine Imports

- **Les Fleurs du Sud “Flowers” Rose’ – France** - This beautiful pale-pink colored rose’ is a refreshing and well-balanced wine. It offers a gorgeous mélange of upfront citrus, bright spring flowers and strawberry aromas that are framed by hints of crisp mouthwatering notes, finishing snappy and fresh. **\$11.95**
- **Natale Verga Pinot Grigio – Italy** – Intense straw yellow, on the palate it reveals well balanced and light flavors of apple and pear, mineral and almond notes on the finish. Perfect as an aperitif or paired with seafood, white meats and grilled fish. **\$13.95**
- **Octopoda Sauvignon Blanc Napa – California** - This Sauvignon Blanc boasts aromas that brim with tropical fruit and citrus notes intertwined with nuances of white flowers. There are intense layers of pineapple, grapefruit, tangerine, and orange blossom on the palate. Try with lighter fair or just on its own! **\$17.95**
- **Natale Verga Moscato D’ Asti – Italy** - Lightly sparkling, or “frizzante” as the Italians say, this famed wine from the Piedmont region is like sipping sweet, bubbly nectar. Aromatic and loaded with succulent apricot, peach and crisp red apple notes, the wine finishes clean and is never overtly sweet or cloying. **\$12.95**
- **Octopoda Cabernet – California** - This red wine has firm structured tannins. It has a long, strong and flavorful finish of vanilla which come from the French Oak barrels. On the palate notes of black currants and licorice. Opaque purple color which extends to the brim of the glass and pairs well with beef, duck or lamb. **\$15.95**
- **Dead Canyon Ranch Cabernet – Washington** - Offering a nose of black currants, blackberry and blueberry fruit, and secondary notes of graphite and roasted black truffles. A gutsy wine, with integrated tannins and very affordable. Pairs well with grilled lamb chops or steaks. **\$17.95**
- **Natale Verga La Storia 1895 Rosso Toscana – Italy** - Deep purple. Fruity bouquet with notes of ripe cherry and blackberry, enriched with cocoa and balsamic nuances. Wide and persistent on the palate thanks to silky and present tannins, embellished with spicy notes derived by an elegant aging. Great with meat and vegetables dishes, great with spicy ingredients such as curry and chili pepper. **\$17.95**

- **RouteStock Chardonnay – California** - Brilliant straw color with aromas of wild thyme, fresh oregano, Meyer lemon and seckel pear. Bright yet expansive with an amazing balance of lemon, pear, fresh herbs and a slight kiss of very pretty French oak to create a mesmerizingly complex wine that balances between lean/crisp and opulent/effusive. The long lingering finish brings you back for another sip! **\$19.95**
- **Tomassi Le Fornaci Lugana – Italy** - Intense and bright yellow on the nose it is fruity and fragrant, with notes of tropical fruit and grapefruit. The taste is dry and harmonious and it has an elegant freshness. It is intense, persistent and mineral with the typical hint of almond finish. **\$19.95**
- **Frescobaldi Remole Rosso Toscana – Italy** - Beautiful bright and intense color. On the nose, it presents hints of small red and black fruits, followed by a delicate spiciness that is accompanied by balsamic hints. It makes pleasantness its main characteristic by combining elegance and persistence. Softness and harmonized. Can be enjoyed with a wide variety of dishes. **\$11.95**
- **10000 Hours Cabernet – Washington** - Black cherry, plum, warm vanilla, and espresso bean on the nose. Huge entry on the palate leads to a super-rich, dense mid-palate with round, chewy tannins. Long finish, driven by black fruit notes and hints of toast. Always highly rated! **\$24.95**
- **Aquilini A56 Cabernet – Washington** - Intense and brooding aromatics. Blackberry, plum, mocha, graphite, fresh herb and hints of leather and earth. The palate is powerful and elegant at the same time. A long finish framed by ample tannins. Enjoy with red meat and rich sauces, with a roasted rack of lamb, a decadent cassoulet, or perhaps a brown butter and sage squash ravioli. **\$29.95**
- **Trefethen Cabernet Oak Knoll – California** - A wine of depth and dignity, this expression of Napa Valley Cabernet reflects everything we have learned farming our estate in the cool climate of the Oak Knoll District since 1968. Dark fruit on the palate, we maintain a bright and lively peppery spiciness, resulting in a wine of impeccable balance that evolves beautifully in both the glass and the cellar. **\$59.95**
- **Masi “Costasera” Amarone – Italy** - Dark ruby red color. Baked fruit, plums and cherries on the nose. Fruity tastes, with hints of coffee and cocoa. Very well balanced. Excellent as an after-dinner wine, or to go with red meat, game, quails and richly-flavored dishes, as well as well-aged cheeses, such as parmesan, pecorino and gorgonzola. **\$69.95**

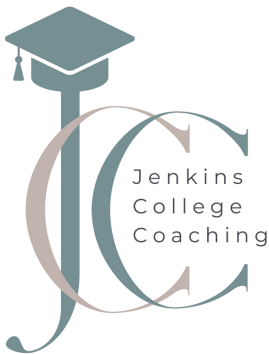
PSP Global Wines

- **El Brazo Albarino – Spain** - Clean and bright with high intensity at the nose. Very fragrant, fruity, floral, and subtle with fresh flavors of peach, pineapple and apricot. Persistent and powerful in the mouth from start to finish. **\$21.95**
- **Suvali Chardonnay – California** - Fresh apples, citrus, caramel and hints of oak on the nose. Baked apples and pear on the palate with hints of vanilla and coconut. Medium-bodied with a creamy texture and lingering, fresh finish. Suvali has a perfect balance of fresh fruit, spice and food friendly acidity. Pair with lighter foods like salads, seafood or soft, mild cheeses. **\$15.95**
- **Vallee des Pin Rose’ – France** - Pale rosé by design. On the nose, red fruits like raspberries and strawberries come out with more exotic fruits like guava in the background. On the palate, fresh and clean, emphasizing ripe strawberries and perfectly balanced acidity. This wine will work perfectly with Mediterranean cuisine such as eggplant gratin, mussels in cream sauce or barbecued meat. **\$16.95**
- **Zucchi Lambrusco di Sorbana – Italy** - A frizzante that's dry with firm acidity and aromas of fresh raspberries and violets. Quite different from the inky, dark Lambrusco most people are used to drinking. The fruit is redder and the texture far more delicate. The name "Lambrusco" actually refers to a large family of grapes, much like Moscato or Pinot. This Lambrusco di Sorbara will evolve for years to come. **\$15.95**
- **Bodegas Olarra Nucerro Rioja Reserva – Spain** - After spending 20 months in the cask, this Reserva wine is now at its peak for tasting, promising an excellent future evolution over the next few years. Cherry red with ruby highlights. Complex, fine aromas. Round and well balanced on the palate, as a result of its long period in the bottle. **\$19.95**
- **Alto de la Ballena Red (Tannat, Merlot, Cabernet Franc) – Uruguay** - A wine that surprises every time you taste it. Its bright red color is remarkable, thanks to the combination of three grape varieties; notes of ripe fruit, raisins, and tobacco. It has a very smooth attack on the palate, yet is intense, with a very persistent finish. **\$21.95**
- **Vallebelbo “Le Filere” Barolo – Italy** - Garnet red color with light nuances. The nose reveals balsamic scents, tones of forest floor, notes of leather, and hints of licorice. Rounded and austere, it has a well-integrated tannin, a full body and exceptional persistence. An age able wine ready to drink now! **\$39.95**
